

**VESTFOLD FYLKESKOMMUNE SCHOLARSHIP
APPROXIMATE COST OF LIVING etc.**

Students are required to spend a minimum of 30 weeks (class time) in Glasgow and a maximum of 52 weeks (class time + dissertation).

There are other options available. Students may wish to do more than 30 weeks in Glasgow but less than 52 weeks. The dissertation can be done whilst based in Norway.

Please note that all figures are approximate and are subject to alterations in the exchange rate. The costs will of course also vary in accordance with the length of time that is spent in Glasgow, for example:

NOTES

As the normal cost of being a student in Norway for a year is approximately 120,000 NKR, the Vestfold Fylkeskommune Scholarship allows you to complete your MSc qualification in an intensive period of 52 weeks, at reasonable cost.

Please bear in mind that students will also be eligible to funding from their usual sources.

The Vestfold Fylkeskommune Scholarship is EXTRA money, over and above the normal funding available to students.
