



## Kristian Berg Harpviken

Kristian Berg Harpviken is a senior researcher and deputy director at the International Peace Research Institute in Oslo (PRIO). He is a sociologist from the University of Oslo. His doctoral thesis focuses on the micro-foundations of forced migration, applying a network perspective to the study of decision-making, impacts on the home community, and repatriation.

Harpviken has also worked on civil society, transnationalism, political mobilisation, as well as a variety of issues related to post-war reconstruction and peace-building. Harpviken has published 16 academic articles and a number of reports and press commentaries, in addition to being widely used as a media commentator and lecturer.

He is the leader of the working group on Transnational and International Facets of Civil War within PRIO's Centre for the Study of Civil War.
