APPROXIMATE COST OF LIVING etc.**

FULLTIME – Glasgow Caledonian University, Glasgow / London (1 year)

Students are required to spend a minimum of 30 weeks (2 days per week class time) in Glasgow and a maximum of 1 year: class time plus dissertation

The dissertation can be undertaken whilst based in Norway.

PARTTIME – Glasgow Caledonian University, Glasgow / London (2 years)

Students are required to spend a minimum of 60 weeks (1 day per week class time) in Glasgow or London over 2 years: class time plus dissertation

The dissertation can be undertaken whilst based in Norway.

PART TIME ON-LINE STUDY Norway based (2 years)

Students are required to spend a minimum of 60 weeks (Private study / distance learning) and to attend 4 intensive teaching weekends (4-5) days over the 2 year period.

Students can complete this method of study in a minimum of 2 years.

All work can be undertaken based in Norway via standard internet access
